

The Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes Official Statement

The Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes Conference stands for and will tirelessly work for harmony among the Hebrew Community.

We recognize the existence of several different beliefs within the Hebrew Faith, operating under various traditions and doctrines – many of which are in conflict with one another. Though it is often necessary to divide over certain teachings and traditions, too often these points of disagreement cause unnecessary division in the Hebrew Community, hindering our ability to effectively fulfill the scriptures to be **One Israel.**

Although there are several different expressions of the Hebrew faith, we must all submit to the fundamental tenets of Torah. For example, though the United States of America consists of 50 different states operating under their own individual sets of laws, they are all subject to one constitution. In the same way, we believe that though there are several different Hebrew communities operating under their own individual doctrines and traditions, we are all subject to the same unifying tenets of the scriptures we consider as essential doctrine.

Let's be reminded that the Great Awakening exist to perpetuate unity among the Hebrew Awakening movement and to encourage all groups within the community to do the same. Everything the Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes Conference and Tours do and promote is toward that end. Therefore, in our effort to spread the true gospel to our people most effectively and unify awakened Israelites, we are inclusive of any and all who can agree with our Statement of Unity, which we believe is based on the Scriptures.

In the fourth chapter of Sha'ul letter to the Ephesians, the Apostle exhorts the assembly in Ephesus to "make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace", and then he lays out the points of doctrine that we should be unified in.

"Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit – just as you were called to one hope when you were called – one Yah, one faith, one baptism; one Elohim and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all." - Ephesians 4:3-6



Every community within the Hebrew diaspora is entitled to their subjective views, doctrines, and even commentaries on the pros and cons of events sponsored by the Great Awakening -- as we welcome and encourage constructive feedback as the how to improve our approach to awake Black America to their true Identity and promote unity amongst true Israel.

However, any commentary, proposal or action that seeks to openly ridicule or attack other fellow Israelite groups or classes of individuals, who attended a Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes function, based on doctrines, stereotypic profiles, garment wear, vernacular, or gender is in opposition to the core objectives and values established by the Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes Conference and Tours....which is UNITY!

We encourage anyone that believes that a brother, sister, or group who attended a Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes Mega Conference or Tour is in error of Torah or is violating the Scriptures, we strongly encourage parties not to take to social media platforms to rebuke, scorn, or share their disdain but rather reach out to the brother, sister, or group privately and use it as a teaching moment that you may gain a brother or sister. "If your brother sins against you, go and rebuke him in private. If he listens to you, you have won your brother." - Matthew 18:15

Israelites publicly ridiculing each other is contrary to the Scriptures and do not promote the unity of the bond of peace. The scriptures teach us that when one of us have a dispute or grievance with another believer, it is a shame to go before public law or expose the grievance to the unrighteous spectators in secular settings to decide the matter instead of taking it to other believers! - I Corinthians 6:1

The scriptures meant for Israel to handle our issues within our own community and not to air it out publicly. Such behavior is self-destructive and doesn't draw people to the Faith but away from it. We believe that handling matters internally is the true Israelite way!
