WELCOME

HEBREW VOYAGE & HUMANITARIAN MISSIONS

We are so excited to have you join The Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes 2019 Hebrew Voyage and Bahamas Humanitarian Mission commemorating 400 years of bondage in the Americas. We will be Sailing for 3 days from Orlando aboard the Carnival Liberty to the beautiful Bahamas. On board you are more than a passenger; you are on a voyage as a missionary for the Almighty Yah.

On this vessel, you will hear teachings from leading Hebrew voices such as Dr. Kenneth Howard, Lorvins Lormeus, Onleilove Alston and Zion Lexx. We will arrive in the Bahamas on Saturday, December 7, 2019 and stay overnight on the Island.

Due to the recent Hurricane, the Great Awakening has adopted a Humanitarian Mission effort to provide aid and preach the Gospel of the Kingdom to Bahamians who've been devastated by Hurricane Dorian. We have been working with Awakened Bahamian natives Tomiko Evans and Lorvin Lormeus to develop strategies to better serve the natives. We have organized efforts to support emergency hygiene, food, and psychosocial support for people directly and indirectly affected by Hurricane Dorian.

On Saturday, December 7, 2019 between 12-4 pm participants (approx. 40 Hebrews from the U.S.) will host a "Awaken the Islands" Event at Western Esplanade Beach, Nassau, The Bahamas. This event has been organized and will be facilitated by Nassau native Tomiko Evans.

We will use this Sabbath to do redemptive work in bringing hope and truth to our brothers and sisters in the Bahamas. We ask that you wear your official "Hebrew Voyage and Humanitarian Relief" Shirt on the Island. Lorvins Lormeus will be performing a live concert with his Hebrew Truth Music, we will be preaching of the Besorah (Gospel of the Kingdom), and sharing conclusive evidence revealing to the natives that they are the bloodline "Children of Israel." Also, at this event, we will provide tents where we will be distributing food, water, hygiene essentials and supplies.

We will organize three teams: Relief Procurement Team, Besorah/Prayer Team After Care Team and a Logistics Team during our Official Welcome, Worship & Strategy Meeting on Friday December 6th at 7pm in the Tapestry Room. We will have an Official Debriefing Meeting on Sunday December 8th at 11:30pm to discuss our experience. Lastly, we desire all to join us for dinner on Sunday at 6:00pm. We ask that you wear ALL-WHITE for the dinner.

We hope that the relief mission and the onboard accommodations and amenities will leave you with memories that last a lifetime.

“The Great Awakening”, provides attendees with practical knowledge and tools that they can use to continue to awaken the dispersed of Israel. We endeavor to:

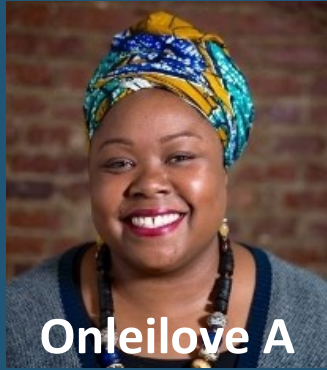
- To raise awareness about how African Americans and other Bantus Negroes around the world are fulfilling biblical prophecy by rediscovering their ancient identity

Onleilove A

Onleilove (pronounced Onlylove) Chika Alston, Founder of Prophetic Whirlwind was born and raised in East New York, Brooklyn. Onleilove is also a community organizer, speaker, and writer. After receiving her bachelor's degree in Human Development with a minor in African-American studies from Penn State University, she completed a year of service with AmeriCorps Public Allies New York. In 2011, she received her Master of Divinity and Master of Social Work degrees from Union Theological Seminary and Columbia University School of Social Work, respectively. Her writing has been featured in Sojourners Magazine, Huff Post Religion, The Black Commentator and NPR's On Being blog, as well as in other print and online publications. Having experienced poverty and homelessness, she has developed a compassion for people fueled by her passion for justice and knows that the gospel is truly "good news to the poor." Onleilove served as the second executive director at PICO-Faith in New York, where she led a multiracial and multifaith organizing federation of 70+ congregations representing 80,000 New Yorkers who are working to Build the Beloved City-where all of The Creator's children can live in dignity. She has completed the Women's Campaign School at Yale, The Collegeville Institute Fellowship and the FPWA Faith and Justice Fellows Program. Onleilove writes and lectures on the implicit

bias of colorism and its impact on African-American women; having developed A Women's Theology of Liberation and Live Free W.O.M.B. (Women Organizing Out of Mass Incarceration and Brutality) for the Faith in Action Network. In 2016 Onleilove testified before the United Nations Working Group for People of African Descent on Mass Incarceration's Impact on Black Women & Girls. She has been a featured speaker and workshop facilitator at CCD, Dartmouth College, Why Christian, Sojourners Summit, The 2015 African Hebrew Conference in Israel and The Samuel Dewitt Proctor Conference among other conferences, congregations, universities and organizations. Often ministering among African Hebrew communities, she was appointed as the Ambassador and given the title of Iyom for The Organization of Igbo-Hebrew Heritage Cultural Foundation's Joseph Project which seeks to build a link between diaspora Africans and Igbos. For her writing and activism work, Onleilove has received the Public Allies New York Local Alumni Award, The Lost Angels Society Survivor Award, The Bennett Fellowship for Social Justice from Auburn Seminary, the National Association of Social Workers-NYC Scholarship for Social Justice, United Food and Commercial Workers International Union Minority Coalition Young Adult Award, and the 2011 Evangelical Press Association's Student Writer of the Year First Place Award for her Sojourners cover story: "Dethroning King Coal: Christians defend a way of life, and the earth, in Appalachia." Her travels and work have taken her to Scotland, England, Switzerland, Israel, Ghana Nigeria, Puerto Rico, The US Virgin Islands, St. Martin, Morocco and Togo. Onleilove has 5 siblings and a large extended family. She worships at Beth-El The House of Yahweh in the South Bronx a 65-year old Messianic Hebrew community. Lorvins L

Lorvins "L" Lormeus You might not be able to readily call his name from the top of your head, but chances are, you've definitely heard one of his tracks or enjoyed the fruits of his musical labor. He has worked with Southern stars as Bubba Sparks, Tampa Tony, and DJ Trans and produced international platinum recording artist Turbulence's hit single "Love Me For Me." Steady in his efforts and quiet in his approach, Tampa, Fla.-based producer Lorvins "L" Lormeus was one of yesterday's most recognizable talents in urban music. The tide has now turned as Lorvins has embarked on a new phenomenon call "Truth Music" a genre of music that reveals the truth about the true Hebrew Israelites in the Bible. This is due to a global awakening prophecy in the Bible orchestrated by Yahuah (God) himself. In 2009, Lormeus landed a major label deal for J Streetz's 2010 single "Country Boy" in conjunction with indie imprint Phresh 2 Def Records and Universal/ Republic subsidiary Devine Records. "Music is an extension of my senses." Born in Freeport, Bahamas, those senses were instilled in the producer / singer / songwriter for as long as he's been alive. He started singing in church at an early age. In school, he was always the first one chosen whenever musical talents were needed amongst his peers. Better known as L, Lorvins started to formerly groom his singing abilities at Dillard High School. As a part of the performing arts high

school's Ashanti Cultural Arts program, he was awarded the opportunity to perform for the Lexus Corporation on the televised ABC Network. Because of his formal training, he has been well received for performing various genres jazz, opera, classical, Negro spirituals, gospel and mainstream music. Over time, versatility would become the niche to define the style that L would now be known for. "Wherever there was a piano," L recalls, "I was going to test it."



Zion Lexx

Zion Lexx's journey in the Hebrew Israelite community began 26 years ago at the age of 14. 3 of his closest friends, who were all brothers, introduced him into this way of life. He started off at a Temple in Brooklyn New York known as Beth Ab Shalom, a Temple with direct lineage to Rabbi Mat hew's commandment keepers in Harlem. At that time he chose the Hebrew name: "Avdiel Ben Levi". From Their there he moved on to Temple Shma Yisrael where he became a teacher, joined the ranks of an order of young Men known as the: S.O.G, an acronym for "Sons of Yah", and by the year 1997 he also became a contributing writer for Shma Israel's news Monthly newspaper entitled "The 3rd Eye News". At this time Zion Lexx was also a student at John Jay College of Criminal Justice in New York City where he later graduated and even obtained his New York State EMT Paramedic certification. After years of teaching and doing community service he went back to College, this time Tuoro College, where he studied Hebrew language and Biblical History. It was around this time that he was asked by: Nasi Yashuvel to join the Hebrews in the ongoing dialogues and debates in the conscious community, the most famous of them being: "Kemet on Trial", which unfortunately Zion Lexx never actually got the opportunity to speak at and thus he

penned a book on it also entitled: "Ancient Kemet on Trial", which included the lecture he wished to share during that epic event. Zion Lexx went on to publish a total of 5 more books with 3 currently pending, due to be released before Passover 2020. Zion has partnered recently with New York City's "Metropolitan Museum of Art", where he has host half a dozen museum lectures to date, where he employs his knowledge of history, culture, and ancient languages to demonstrate his views and points. He offers a beginners class on Biblical Hebrew as well as Medu Neter also known as the hieroglyphs. His official titles held in the community he hails from in NYC is Moreh meaning teacher, and Rosh meaning Chief.

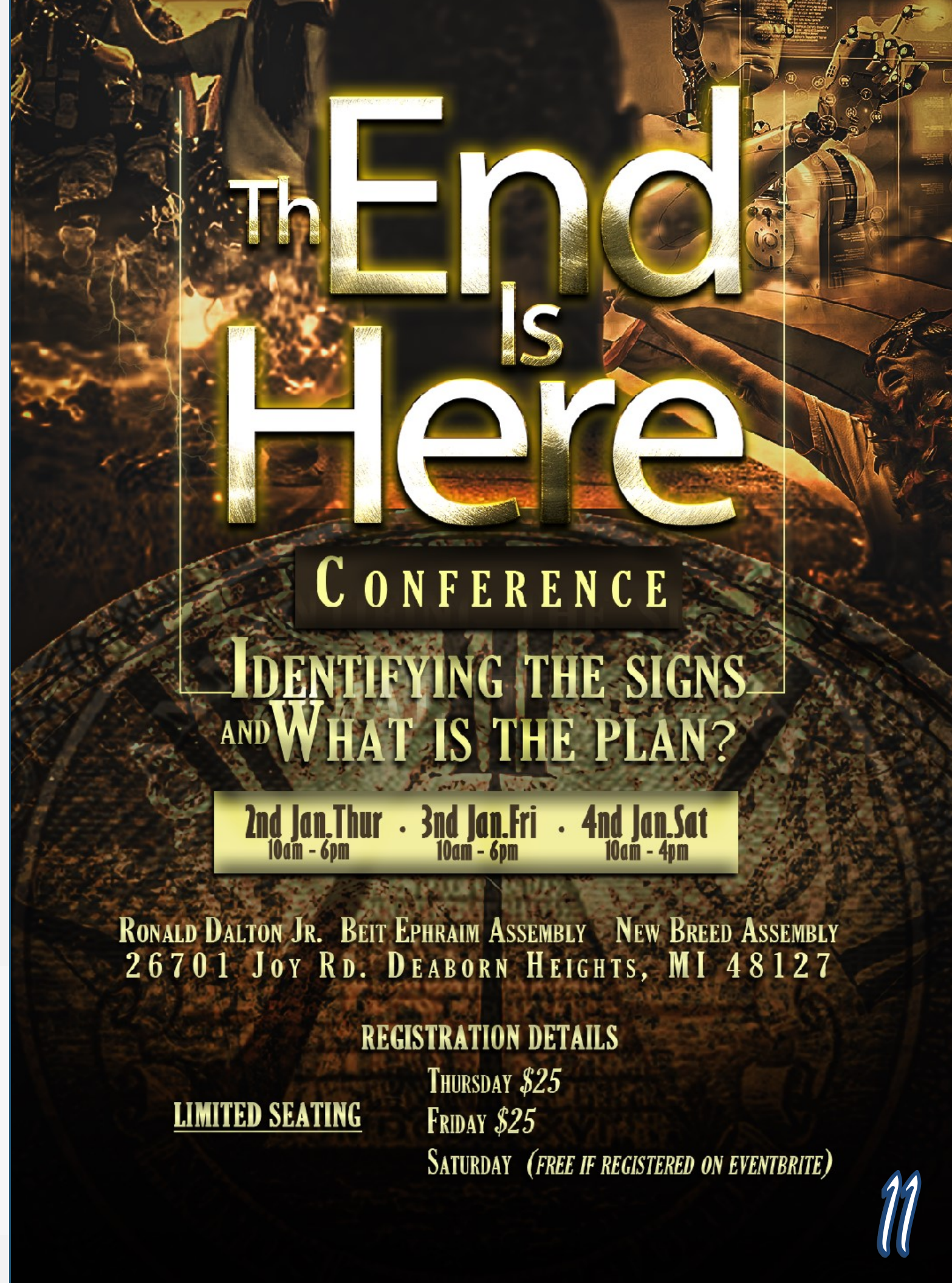

NASSAU BAHAMAS

With the lure of a big city and the ease of tropical utopia, Nassau & Paradise Island are considered by many as, well, paradise. Nassau, the capital of The Bahamas, is a bustling metropolitan hub full of culture and modern amenities. To the north lies Paradise Island. Its name tells you everything. It's 685 acres of pure euphoria, developed almost exclusively to delight and accommodate visitors. The island boasts resorts, hotels, restaurants, shops, nightlife, a golf course, an aquarium and a casino.



FOOD

Take the opportunity to discover Bahamian cuisine while you're there. It's spicy and uniquely flavored. Beginning with local ingredients—tropical fruit, and spices—their eateries run the gamut. Down-home restaurants will feature traditional Bahamian favorites, while more artisan options will combine international cuisine with island flavor. We highly recommend that you stay away from the seafood in observance of the dietary laws (Leviticus 11, Deuteronomy 14).

BEACHES

The Bahamas is known for its stellar beaches. With over 2,000 breathtaking islands and cays, and the clearest water on Earth, it's no wonder visitors come here from all around to sink their toes into miles of pure white, and in some places pink, sand—the very definition of paradise.

ECO-TOURISM

When it comes to nature, The Bahamas has some of the most intriguing, exotic, and mysterious natural phenomena on the planet: the world's deepest blue hole, third-largest fringing barrier reef, and largest colony of pink flamingos. Nature preserves protect the endangered Bahama Parrot and several species of endangered iguanas.

DIVING

The Bahamas offers an array of dive experiences. You'll find sunken Spanish galleons, inland blue holes, underwater caves, and forest-like coral reefs teeming with marine life. You can even feed and swim with reef sharks and get your adrenaline pumping.

GETTING AROUND THE ISLAND

There are several options to help you get around Nassau & Paradise Island. Rental cars, motor scooters, buses and taxis are the most common means of public transportation. Bicycles are not generally available for rental, but some hotels will offer them for the use of their guests. Pedestrians should remember to first look right and then left before crossing streets.

WHAT TO AVOID:

1. **Preach but Don't Argue about the Hebrew Faith** with Natives
2. **Don't Hop in a Taxi Without Negotiating a Fare.** Most taxis don't use meters like they do in other major cities around the world.
3. **Don't Venture Out Without Bringing Cash.** In case of a medical emergency, you'll want to make sure you have cash on hand.
4. **Don't Go to Non-Tourist Areas at Night.** Many of the country's most violent crimes happen on the islands of New Providence and Grand Bahama, and many incidents occur after nightfall.
5. **Don't Eat Unpeeled Fruits & Veggies** You'll probably pass by many fruit stands, but you should definitely keep on walking. Visitors are advised to stay clear of veggies and fruits unless they're cooked or peeled.
6. **Call the Locals By Their First Names** Bahamians are very formal when it comes to strangers. Handshakes are used to greet people, but they will always address you by your last name unless they consider you a close friend. You should do the same in return.
7. **Don't Be Uptight** Bahamians have a wonderful sense of humor, and they won't hesitate to crack jokes at your expense. Don't take things so seriously, and you should definitely learn to laugh at yourself. The locals respect visitors who are kind and humble, and they consider teasing and poking fun as a form of affection.

HERITAGE "THEY'RE HEBREW TOO!"

The Bahamians and Haitians...like other Afro-Caribbeans...all share the same Y-DNA "E1b1a" that is seen throughout West Africa and because of slavery they also share the same Y-DNA "E1b1a" as African-Americans and Afro-Latinos in Latin America. This means that we despite the name of Island or country we live in (i.e. Jamaica, Haiti, Bahamas, Cuba, Antigua, Barbados, America, Guyana, Suriname, Belize, Brazil, Guatemala, Columbia) we are all ONE FAMILY...the descendants of the Children of Israel.



True Israelite Identity of Bantu Negroes in Africa is revealed. Many tribes in West/Central Africa from whom the Bahamian and Haitian people descend from are listed below.

- Temne, Mande, Krio, Wolof, Ashanti, Fante, Eve, Ga, Yoruba, Fon, Igbo, Kikongo, Baluba, Bamileke, Bassa, Tikar, Angolares

These Bantu Tribes were called "Juifs" by the French, "Heeboes (Hebrews)" by the British, "The People of the Books" or "So Yudah" or "Ibn Yacub (Son of Jacob) by the Arabs. These Tribes all tell of a Migration story of how they came left Israel and entered into Africa by way of Egypt. They have Hebrew infused with their "Mother tongue"...not the language of their colonial masters (such as English, French, Portuguese and they all have Traditions/Customs which are identical to the Law of Moses...aka the Torah which was given to the 12 Tribes of Israel by Yah (God) after Moses's encounter with Yah on Mount Sinai. Because of their ancestors disobedience in following the Laws, statues and commandments of God listed in the Book of Deuteronomy and Leviticus...God promised that their children...and children's children would endure what is known as the "Curses of Israel"...one of which included being sold into slavery from one place (Africa) to another (the Bahamas, Haiti etc).

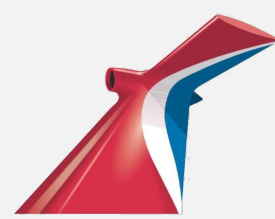


One thing in particular that is unique about these Israelites that left Israel and went into Africa...later having to go through slavery by European Colonial Masters...is the fact that all of the male descendants of these Israelites who scattered into Africa carried the same Paternal Y-DNA "E1b1a". This Genetic Paternal (Father/Patrilineal) marker can be seen widespread in 70% of the people in Sub-Saharan Africa who were subjugated to Slavery... in ALL Afro-Caribbeans, African-Americans, and Afro-Latinos in Central America and South America.

Much of the heritage of the Bahamian people come from regions in African that the British controlled. Such as Sierra Leone, Cameroon, Ghana, Nigeria (Yorubaland/Igboland) and also places where French/Portuguese controlled (Cameroon, Congo/Angola).

Haitian slaves consisted of people from the Gold Coast...in particular the Eve People (Erverh-Hebrew Ibri) pronounced "ibree". The Eve people's history tells of their Exodus from Egypt crossing the Red Sea to the Land of Canaan. Later, after many centuries they fled back to Africa. The Eve people are scattered amongst the Volta region of Eastern Ghana, Togoland, Benin and Yorubaland. They speak the Kwa Languages (Eastern/Western Kwa) which is spoken by many Ghananians, Togolese, and Nigerians. Also, the most rebellious uncontrollable slaves on other Slave Plantations of Igbo descent were also sent to Haiti as a form of punishment. Slaves from the Congo, Cameroon and Angola were also sent to Haiti...whom many were descendants of the Black Jews who were exiled by the Spanish and Portuguese in the 1500's A.D. **They too are your Hebrew Brothers!**

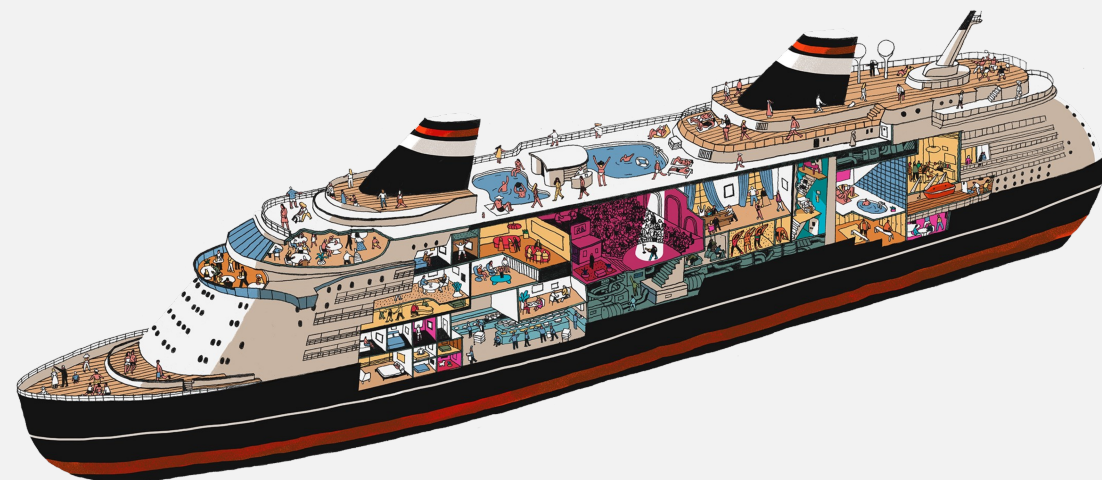

SHARING THE GOOD NEWS

Gospel/Besorah

Hear is a simple approach to sharing the Good News of the Kingdom with Bahamians

GOOD NEWS

The good news is that salvation has come to Israel, not Christians (see Luke 1:68-79) through belief (faith) in Yahusha HaMashiach, the son of YAHUAH, and so we must repent and believe the good news. Mar 1:14-15 Now after that John was put in prison, Yahusha came into Galilee, preaching the good news of the kingdom of Elohim, And saying, The **time is fulfilled**, and the **kingdom of Elohim is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.** So let us see what we should preach about the good news (gospel) according to this verse

- The time is fulfilled: the prophesied Messiah came and fulfilled prophesy of Israel's Messiah
- The kingdom of YAHUAH is at hand: each day draws us closer to the coming kingdom
- Repent – turn from evil
- Believe the good news – believe on the good news of salvation through belief in the Messiah

SALVATION IS FOR ISRAEL

The good news of salvation starts and ends with Israel, not with a new religion called Christianity. Not Israel the country, but Israel a people scattered over the "four corners of the earth" (Isa 11:12). The Bible speaks of salvation for Israel (Luke 1:68-69) through a Messiah sent for Israel. This salvation is through the Messiah Yahusha who was a Yahudym (Jew) of the tribe of Yahudah (Judah). Zec 8:7-8 Thus saith YAHUAH of hosts; Behold, I will save my people from the east country, and from the west country; And I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and they shall be my people, and I will be their Elohim, in truth and in righteousness.

It is important to know that salvation is only for Israel, and gentiles who join themselves to Israel (Isa 56:6-8, Num 15:16). Furthermore, Israel must walk in obedience to YAHUAH'S commandments and laws. That is why they were in need of salvation, because they did not obey the laws of the Most High. As a result, they were given over to their enemies and placed under the curses of the law (Deut 28:15-68).

To redeem us from the curses of the law, the Messiah Yahusha was sent (Gal 3:13). Through belief in him, we will walk as he walked (1 John 2:6) in obedience to the laws and commandments of his Father (John 15:10). There is no provision in scripture, nor prophecy, that a people will walk in disobedience to him and be his people. None!

Eze 36:26-27 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them. The promise of the new covenant is that the Holy Spirit will cause us to walk in obedience to his statutes and judgments (his laws).

ABIDE IN HIM

Now that they have heard the word of truth, the good news of your salvation, they have found the one true Messiah of the bible, denied yourself, repented and baptized in his name: They have found THE WAY. Now is the time to abide in "the way" Study scripture, study Torah, follow the Messiah's commandments, follow the Father's commandments and laws by walking in the Spirit. Learn obedience by the things that you suffer. Abide in him.

Heb 5:8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; The Son walked in the commandments and laws that Christendom has discarded in various degrees. If we follow him, we also must walk as he walked. Generally, he kept the law perfectly, but more specifically he:

- Kept the 7th day Sabbath
- Kept the feasts of YAHUAH
- Did not eat pork, shrimp and other unclean food
- Worshipped the Father
- Did not worship an image
- Was sent for Israel, not Christians
- Never came to start a religion called Christianity
- He was not a Roman (Jesus); he was Hebrew (Yahusha)
- Never told us the LAW was done away with
- Never told us once saved always saved: he told us he that endureth to the end shall be saved

MISSIONS TEAMS

The purpose of the Missions Team is to assist the Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes in their vision of providing humanitarian aid, awakening, reaching, impacting and sharing the good news of the Kingdom to Bahamian natives through an outdoor festive day of events at West Esplanade Beach in Nassau, Bahamas. This Missions Team is responsible for developing, planning, strategizing and coordinating the arrangements of the “Awaken the Nations” Event.

The are three Mission Teams to assist during the “Awaken the Islands” Event.

- ◆ **Relief Procurement Team** is responsible for helping **Lorvins Lormeus** to obtain all food, beverages, accessories, feminine products and additional bulk grocery items needed for the Akaken the Islands Event. At the outreach, the Relief Procurement team oversees Groceries, and accessories which is responsible to unpack pallets and bag groceries, stock grocery distribution tables, and distribute items to the local natives.
- ◆ **The Besorah/Prayer Team** is responsible for assisting **Dr. Ken Howard** in planning gospel-related and prayer activities at the outreach. This team is also responsible for sharing the good news (Besorah) of the Kingdom and wisely sharing the truth about heritage to the natives. At the outreach, the Prayer team will provide leadership to prayer partners and intercessory prayer persons. Prayer partners visit with guests, identify personal needs, and ask for the privilege to pray with guests for those needs. Intercessory prayer teams provide focused prayer and intercession for both guests and mission team. **See the Awakening—How to follow the Way and Bahamas Heritage Brochure for approaches.**
- ◆ **The Logistics Team** is responsible for working with **Tomiko Evans** to obtain much of the equipment and supplies needed for the outreach. This includes fence, stages, sound systems, tables, chairs, tents, electrical power, trash cans and more. In addition, this team is responsible to recruit site setup and cleanup volunteers and oversee all site setup and cleanup responsibilities. At the outreach, the Logistics Team is responsible to oversee the Command Center.
